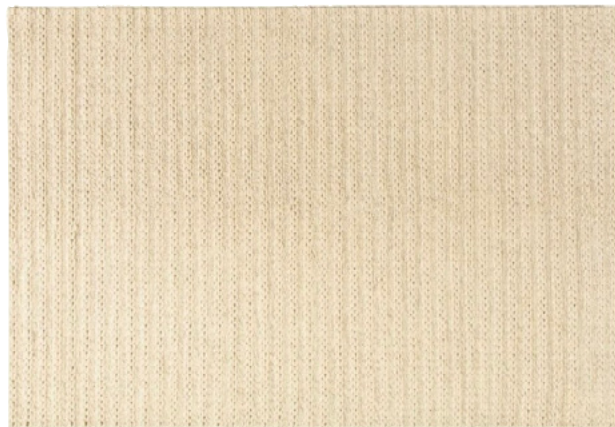

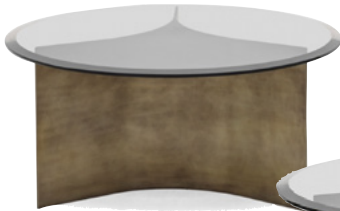

Modern Mid Century



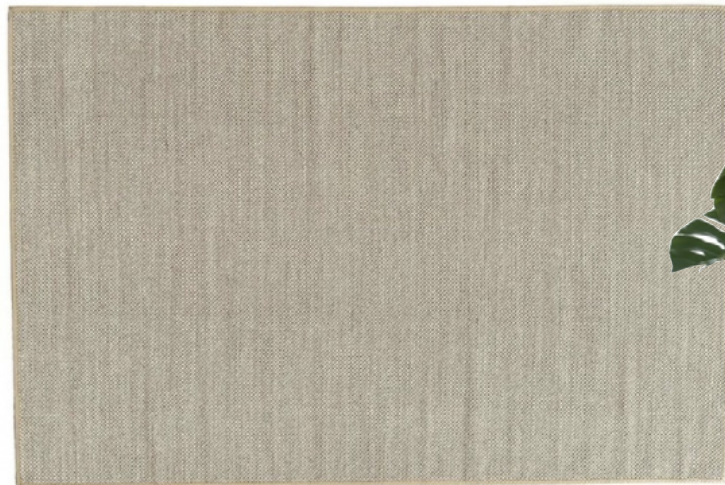

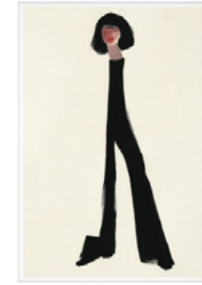
